Behavior & Dismissal Policy

The Afterschool Tutorial Program Code of Conduct Policy ensure the safety of each participant.

All Children enrolled in the Afterschool Tutorial Program are expected to behave appropriately at all times. Inappropriate behavior, bad language, weapons, threats/fights will not be tolerated and may be cause for dismissal. If your child is dismissed for disciplinary reasons; your child will not be allowed to return for the remainder of that year. You may apply the next school term.

Participant Code of Conduct

- Show respect for other participants, and treat them as you wish to be treated.
- Show respect for staff, and cooperate fully with their instructions.
- Respect the rights and beliefs of others.
- Communicate in an appropriate manner, no use foul language or gestures, harsh words or tone of voice.

Horseplay, unwelcome teasing or other unkind behaviors are not allowed.

- Refrain from deliberately causing bodily harm to other participants no hitting even during free play.
- Pushing, kicking, hitting or fighting are not acceptable and will not be tolerated.
- Use program equipment, supplies, and facilities properly.
- Respect the property of others.
- Understand that irresponsible behavior will result in disciplinary action.
